2 BY MR. SUTHERD:

3 Q My question is a very subjective question. I'm
4 asking for your opinion on the process on a scale of one to
5 ten, with one being this meets the absolute minimum or
6 almost meets the minimum and we'll upgrade it as we get
7 these licensing requirements put in, and ten being the
8 perfect, this has all the bells and whistles, in your
9 opinion. And I understand the people that are paying you
10 to design this are sitting here, but you're under oath.
11 What's your opinion of the rating for this plant?

12 A That's kind of a loaded question, like you say,
13 but it's not -- it's not a Model T; it's not a Hummer. But
14 I'd say it's on the order of a seven to eight.
